Milward & Sons, Henry	At times, brand names included Archer, Archerite, "Disc", Double Century, Gold Seal, Knobfast, Milward, Milward-Ernoid, Phantom, Rainbow, Shipbrand or Ship Brand. This was a long-lived firm, which took over or amalgamated with numerous smaller firms during the 19th and early 20th centuries. Logo was a raised arm brandishing a sabre. Milward set up and owned Pony in India before that firm was nationalised in the late 1940's after India's declaration of independence. CC961 has a unique, drum-shaped stopper. also labelled wooden tube. Also pair (CC 1980) hard plastic DP holders with rubber band tension regulators.
