



		bamboo	SP	SEW	Gift from Gay Lines (CC 508). Flat paper sleeve marked with Asian characters and a crane (which is a good luck symbol). "made in Taiwan" printed on the sleeve
		grey coated metal	SP	SEW	metal row counter affixed to as the stopper. "pat app for RD S55514"
		various	SP 4xDO	SEW	Union Jack on label -- gift of Gay Lines who suggests this was used during WW2
		bamboo	straight	JC	resin stopper, flattened sphere on bamboo shaft; owner thinks these are from the 1940's as they belonged to her mother-in-law
		metal	crochet hook	JC	x!x!x! decoration around the shaft above the fingerplate
		metal	straight	SEW	beige tulip-shaped stopper, size in red on stopper, above pretty ordinary coated metal shaft
		metal	straight	SEW	black hemisphere stopper, size on top of stopper in mm
